



**WGMA continues to have a central role
in the development and enjoyment of Grand Masters hockey**

So what is WGMA these days and how has it changed since it was founded in 2002

WGMA is a worldwide members' club for groups/organisations and individuals involved in promoting and managing Grand Masters hockey i.e. hockey for men and women aged 60 and upwards.

WGMA aims to encourage communication between its members and offers expertise and advice in planning individual matches, tours, festivals and events.

WGMA no longer organises tournaments itself but helps clubs to organise their own events for non-national teams and advises on the timing of events by managing a Grand Masters international calendar which is published on its website.

WGMA believes that hockey players Over 60 – Grand Masters – have different requirements and expectations to the Masters who play in younger age groups.

WGMA encourages organisers to include similar age groups for both men and women in their planning of events.

WGMA promotes the understanding that the success of Grand Masters hockey is by combining competitive hockey with enjoyable social interaction with others of a similar age group and in many cases by sharing this experience with their partners.

WGMA is no longer the governing body for Grand Masters hockey but supported and was instrumental in the formation of World Masters Hockey (WMH) now recognised by FIH as the governing body for all Masters hockey from O35 to O80 for both men and women. WMH is now responsible for all matches and events involving official national teams whereas WGMA encourages and promotes the organisation worldwide of social/festival hockey between non-national sides.

To succeed in its aims and to be an effective force in the future success of Grand Masters hockey WGMA needs a broad international membership and needs to be inclusive in its involvement of all those interested in Over 60 hockey in as many countries as possible.
